## FIRST BROADCASTER BRIEFING RECAP

The first Broadcaster Briefing between DAGOC, DAGBS, Qtel and the Rights Holders took place this morning in the IBC Briefing room. The main points addressed at the Briefing were:

### IBC

- The Construction Helpdesk is the point of reference for both IBC construction issues and matters pertinent to DAGOC's Green Policy of Waste Management and recycling.
- DAGBS confirms that the Contribution, Distribution and Transmission room is operational 24 hours a day, is ready for testing and staffed to cover all Rights Holders' needs.
- Supplementary Access Devices (SADs) will be available from the DAGBS Booking Office from 26 November. Rights Holders requiring SADs earlier should refer to the Booking office.

### PRODUCTION

DAGBS informed Rights Holders about the following production issues:

- The Doha Bay & Corniche Beauty Camera (No.1) will be available from 21 November.
- Daily play-outs at 14:00 of the opening sequences and vignettes will begin on 22 November; this will be enhanced by the helicopter fly-over shots and the DAGBS IBC filming of the official Doha 2006 medals, available from 26 November.

### OPENING CEREMONY

Rights Holders were reminded of the following details regarding the Opening Ceremony:

- The DAGOC Media Guide, include timings, credits & notes for the commentators will be available on 26 November. Distribution details will be confirmed when available.
- An Opening Ceremony Press Conference will take place in the MPC Main Conference Room at 12:00 on 28 November.
- The Opening Ceremony rehearsal (for commentators and senior production personnel) will take place on 29 November at 19:00. The registration procedure will be communicated as soon as it is available.
- DAGOC confirms that the Opening Ceremony will last for approx. two and a half hours. Exact duration is still to be finalised
- DAGBS will not be providing coverage of the Opening Ceremony rehearsal.

### QTEL

Qtel will investigate refunding any unopened, unused prepaid cards and the monitoring of costs via a centralised system. Rates will also be made available to Rights Holders.
